

if swallowed	 Call poison control center, or doctor immediately for treatment advice. Have person sip a glass of water if able to swallow. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by the poison control center or doctor. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

This product is used to control the growth of algae in swimming pools, exterior heated pools, spas, whirlpools, and hot tubs. For maximum effectiveness, pools, spas, whirlpools and hot tubs containing heavy growth of algae should be cleaned prior to using this product.

For pools having just visible algae growth, add an initial dose of 36.5 to 56.3 fluid ounces of this product per 10,000 gallons of water and remove settled algae debris by cleaning.

For treatment of freshly cleaned and filled pool, add initially 20 to 36.5 fluid ounces of this product per 10,000 gallons of water.

To maintain pools free of visible algae growth, subsequent additions of 6.5 to 11 fluid ounces of this product per 10,000 gallons of water should be made every 5 to 7 days after initial treatment.

This product is compatible with those chemicals normally used to treat pools and spas and is effective at both acid and alkaline pH. This product can be used in pools and spas treated with chlorine chemicals and may reduce the amount of those chemicals normally required. However, do not mix with concentrated dry or liquid chlorine products.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Store in original container in a cool dry place. Do not reuse empty container. Wrap container and put in trash.
