### DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Winter Algaecide 40 is used to control the growth of algae in swimming pools, during the off-season winter months when pools are not in use. For maximum effectiveness, pools containing heavy growth of algae should be cleaned prior to using Winter Algaecide 40.

For pools having just visible algae growth, add an initial dose of 18 to 27 fluid ounces of Winter Algaecide 40 per 10,000 gallons of water and remove settled algae debris by cleaning. For pools which have been properly treated during the swimming g season and are free of visible algae, add 10 to 18 fluid ounces of Winter Algaecide 40 per 10,000 gallons of water.

If the pool is not covered, it may be necessary to repeat treatment one or two more times throughout the winter months.

Winter Algaecide 40 is compatible with those chemicals normally used to treat pools and effective at both acid and alkaline pH. This product can be used in pools treated with chlorine chemicals and may reduce the amount of those chemicals normally required. However, do not mix Winter Algaecide 40 with concentrated dry or liquid chlorine products.

#### STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Store in original container in a cool dry place. Do not reuse empty container. Wrap container and put in trash.
