

#### **DIRECTIONS FOR USE**

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Olympic Algaecide is used to control the growth of algae in swimming pools, exterior spas and whirlpools, and hot tubs. For maximum effectiveness, pools, spas, whirlpools and hot tubs containing heavy growth of algae should be cleaned prior to using Olympic Algaecide.

For pools having just visible algae growth, add an initial dose of 101 to 156 fluid ounces of this product per 10,000 gallons of water and remove settled algae debris by cleaning.

For treatment of freshly cleaned and filled pool, add initially 56 to 101 fluid ounces of Olympic Algaecide per 10,000 gallons of water. Subsequent additions of 18.4 to 37 fluid ounces of Olympic Algaecide per 10,000 gallons of water should be made every 5 to 7 days after initial treatment for maintenance. Spas, whirlpools and hot tubs having just visible signs of algae growth require an initial dose of 9.18 to 18.36 fluid ounces of Olympic Algaecide per 1,000 gallons of water. For treatment of a freshly cleaned and filled spa, whirlpool or hot tub, add initially 5.51 to 10.1 fluid ounces of Olympic Algaecide per 1,000 gallons of water. Subsequent additions of 1.84 to 3.7 fluid ounces of this product should be made every 5 to 7 days after initial treatment for maintenance.

Olympic Algaecide is compatible with those chemicals normally used to treat pools and spas and is effective at both acid and alkaline pH. Olympic Algaecide can be used in pools and spas treated with chlorine chemicals and may reduce the amount of those chemicals normally required. However, do not mix Olympic Algaecide with concentrated dry or liquid chlorine products.
