Dear Mr. Rosenwasser:

The amendment referred to above, submitted in connection with registration of the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), is conditionally acceptable provided the following changes are made:

- 1. Place the "If Inhaled" treatment regimen under "If On Skin" in the First Aid section.
- 2. Insert the word "separately" between wash and before under the Precautionary statements.
- 3. In the second and third paragraph of the Swimming Pool directions change 1.5 ppm to 2.0 ppm. Change "the" to "is" and add "of that product" to the end of the last sentence of the second paragraph.



If inhaled	 Move person to fresh air. If person is not breathing, call 911 or an ambulance, then give artificial respiration, preferably by mouth-to-mouth, if possible. Call a poison control center or doctor for further treatment advice.
If on skin or clothing	 Take off contaminated clothing. Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15-20 minutes. Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice.
ff swallowed	 Call poison control center, or doctor immediately for treatment advice. Have person sip a glass of water if able to swallow. Do not induce vorniting unless told to do so by the poison control center or doctor. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

PHYSICAL AND CHEMICAL HAZARDS:

Strong Oxidizing Agent. Mix only with water. Use clean dry utensils. Do not add this product to any dispensing device containing remnants of any other product. Such use may cause a violent reaction leading to fire or explosion. Contamination with moisture, organic matter, or other chemicals may start a chemical reaction, with generation of fire and explosion. In case of contamination or decomposition, do not reseal container. If possible isolate container in open air or well ventilated area. Flood with large volumes of water, if necessary.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. When used as directed, this product is effective as a pool water disinfecting agent.

FOR SWIMMING POOLS

The filter system should be backwashed or properly cleaned and the pH adjusted between 7.2 and 7.6. It is recommended that the pool be initially stabilized with 30-40 ppm cyanuric acid to reduce dissipation effect of sunlight on chlorine. In addition to chlorine, this product introduces cyanuric acid into the pool to maintain this stabilizing effect.

A free available chloine residual of 1.0 to 1.5 ppm must first be established in the pH adjusted and conditioned pool. It the is recommended that this be done with a concentrated product, following the directions on the label.

Maintain a free chlorine residual of 1.0 to 7:5 ppm by placing one (1) Skimmer Stick per 5,000 gallons of pool water into the skimmer or automatic feeding device per week. Usage may vary depending upon bather load and environmental conditions. Do not add any other chemical through the skimmer when using this product in the skimmer.

The regular use of a test kit will determine if further adjustments may be necessary to maintain the recommended level of free available chlorine in the pool water.

NOTE: Re-entry into treated swimming pools is prohibited above levels of 3.0 ppm of chlorine.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Keep this product dry in original tightly closed container when not in use. Store in a cool, dry, well ventilated area away from heat or open flame. Moisture may decompose this product and cause a violent reaction leading to fire and explosion. In case of decomposition, isolate container if possible and flood area with large volumes of water to dissolve all material before discarding this container. Do not contaminate food or feed by storage or disposal.
