Dear Mr. Rosenwasser:

The amendment referred to above, submitted in connection with registration of the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), is conditionally acceptable provided the following changes are made:

1. Place the "If Inhaled" treatment regimen under "If On Skin" in the First Aid section.
2. Insert the word "separately" between wash and before under the Precautionary statements.
3. In the second and third paragraph of the Swimming Pool directions change 1.5 ppm to 2.0 ppm. Change "the" to "is" and add "of that product" to the end of the last sentence of the second paragraph.
