The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, is acceptable provided that you:

1. Make the following revisions before you release the product for shipment bearing the amended labeling.
  - a. Delete "General Classification."
  - b. Include Container Disposal instructions. Refer to PR Notices 83-3 and 84-1 in this regard.
  - c. Delete the second paragraph under Storage and Disposal. These are Environmental Hazard statements.
  - c. Revise the Environmental Hazards section as follows:

This pesticide is toxic to fish. Treated effluent should not be discharged where it will drain into lakes, streams, ponds or public waters unless in accordance with an NPDES permit. For guidance contact the Regional Office of EPA. Do not contaminate water when disposing of equipment washwaters. Apply this pesticide only as specified on this label.

**DANGER:** Highly corrosive. Causes skin and eye damage. May be fatal if swallowed, gets in eyes, on skin, or on clothing. Wear goggles or face shield and rubber gloves. Irritating to nose and throat. Avoid breathing dust. Remove and wash contaminated clothing before reuse.

**PRACTICAL TREATMENT (FIRST AID):** If swallowed, promptly drink one glass of water or milk. DO NOT induce vomiting. Get medical attention. Avoid further exposure. **PHYSICAL AND CHEMICAL HAZARDS, STRONG OXIDIZING AGENT:** Oxidizing Agent. Mix only with water. Use clean, dry utensils. Do not add this product to a deepening device containing remnants of any other product. Such use may cause a reaction leading to fire or explosion. Contamination with moisture, organic materials, or other chemicals may start a chemical reaction, with generation of heat, liberation of gases, and possible generation of fire and explosion. In case of contamination or spill, do not reseal container. If possible, isolate container in open air or well ventilated area. Flood with large volumes of water, if necessary.

## DIRECTIONS FOR USE GENERAL CLASSIFICATION

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. This product provides a stable form of chlorine for winterization. Test pH and adjust, if necessary, to 7.4-7.6. With the pool pump in operation, broadcast Winter Prep into the deep end of the pool. Use 1 pound per 10,000 gallons of water. Vacuum, and clean out skimmer baskets and hair and lint trap. Backwash filter. Follow manufacturer's directions concerning the winterization of equipment. Add 1/2 quart of Winter Guard per 10,000 gallons of water. Before covering pool, to insure that metal stains do not occur during the winter months, add 1 quart of Metal Inhibitor per 10,000 gallons of water.

## STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Keep product dry in tightly closed container when not in use. Store in a cool, dry, well-ventilated area away from heat or open flame. Keep contents and container dry and off wet floors. In case of fire, use dry chemical extinguisher. Do not discharge into water. If decomposition occurs, isolate container, if possible, and flood with large amounts of water to solve all materials before decarding. Place in trash collection or dispose in approved area. This product is toxic to fish. Treated effluent should not be discharged where it can reach lakes, streams, ponds, or public water. Do not contaminate water by cleaning of disposal of wastes. Apply this product only as specified on this label.
