Based on your response to the Reregistration Eligibility Document, EPA has reregistered the above named product subject to the comments recorded in the succeeding paragraph. This action is taken under the authority of section 4(g)(2)(C) of the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended. Reregistration under this section does not eliminate the need for continual reassessment of pesticides. EPA may require submission of data at any time to maintain the registration of your product.

Make the following labeling changes before you release the product for shipment:

1. Refer to the enclosed Attachment A for the necessary revisions to the Precautionary Statements for the subject product.
2. Revise the Environmental Hazards to read as follows:

"This pesticide is toxic to fish and aquatic organisms. Do not discharge effluent containing this product into lakes, streams, ponds, estuaries, oceans or public waters unless this product is specifically identified and addressed in an NPDES permit. Do not discharge effluent containing this product to sewer systems without previously notifying the sewage treatment plant.

PHYSICAL AND CHEMICAL HAZARDS: Mix only with water. Use clean, dry equipment. Do not add this product to any dispensing device containing remnants of any other product. This may cause a violent reaction leading to fire or explosion. Contamination with organic matter, or other chemicals may start a chemical reaction, with generation of flammable, toxic, or hazardous gases, and possible generation of fire and explosion. In case of fire, do not use water for decomposition, do not reseal container. If possible, isolate container in open area. Flood with large volumes of water, if necessary.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with the label. This product provides a stable form of chlorine for winterization.

Test pH and adjust, if necessary, to 7.4—7.6. With the pool pump in operation, add product into the deep end of the pool. Use 1 pound per 10,000 gallons of water. Vacuum, and clean out skimmer baskets and hair and lint trap. Backwash filter through manufacturer's directions concerning the winterization of equipment.

Add 1/2 quart of Winter Guard per 10,000 gallons of water. Before covering pool, to insure that metal stains do not occur during the winterization, add 1/2 quart of Scale & Metal Control per 10,000 gallons of water.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE INSTRUCTIONS: Keep product dry in tightly closed container. Store in a cool, dry, well ventilated area away from heat or open flame. Keep container dry and off wet floors.

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL: Securely wrap original container in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash.

CONTAINER DISPOSAL: Do not reuse empty container. Rinse thoroughly with water. Collect in trash collection or disposing in an approved landfill area.
