DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Winter Guard will prevent the growth of most algae during the winter months when pools are not in use. For pools already treated during the swimming season and for new pools, apply 1/2 to 1 pint of Winter Guard per 10,000 gallons of water. Some visible algae growth at the end of the swimming season may require 1 to 2 pints of Winter Guard per 10,000 gallons of water. Apply uniformly throughout the pool to assure maximum effectiveness. If the pool is not covered, it may be necessary to reapply one or more times during the season.

Winter Guard is compatible with those chemicals used in pools treated with chlorine chemicals. It is not compatible with concentrated dry or liquid products.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Keep container closed when not in use. Empty containers should be placed in a plastic bag and cleaned up with clear water. All pesticides should be kept out of reach of children and stored away from food.

DISPOSAL: Do not reuse empty containers. Recycle where available. Otherwise, discard in trash.
