

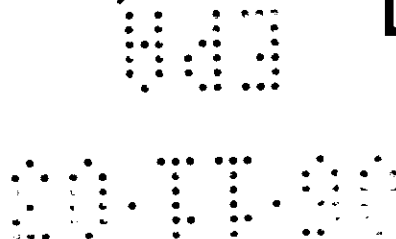

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

This product will prevent the growth of most algae during the off-season winter months when pools are not in use. For pools which have been properly treated during the swimming season and are free of visible algae, add ½ to 1 pint of this product per 10,000 gallons of water. For pools having some visible algae growth at the end of the swimming season, add 1 to 1 ½ pints of this product per 10,000 gallons of water. Distribute this product uniformly throughout the pool to ensure maximum effectiveness. If the pool is not covered, it may be necessary to repeat the treatment one or more times during the season.

This product is compatible with those chemicals normally used to treat pools and is effective at both acid and alkaline pH. This product can be used in pools treated with chlorine chemicals and may reduce the amount of those chemicals normally required. However, do not mix with concentrated dry or liquid chlorine products.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Store in original container in a cool dry place. Do not reuse empty container. Wrap container and put in trash.
