- In your Statement of Practical Treatment, change the "If swallowed" sentence to read: "If swallowed drink large quantities of water. Do not induce vomiting. Avoid alcohol. Call a physician immediately."

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

DANGER: Harmful if swallowed. Avoid breathing vapors, or clothing.

FIRST AID: If swallowed, drink promptly a large quantity of water, or, if these are not available, drink large quantities of milk. Call a physician immediately.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS: This pesticide is toxic to fish, lakes, streams, or ponds. Permits may be required for discharge into lakes, streams, ponds, or public waters. For more information, contact the nearest office of the Environmental Protection Agency.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Algaecide 60 is used to control the growth of algae in swimming pools, hot tubs, and hot tubs. For maximum effectiveness, pools and hot tubs containing heavy growth of algae should be cleaned before treatment.

For pools having just visible algae growth, add an initial dose of Algaecide 60 per 10,000 gallons of water and re-cleanse. For treatment of a freshly cleaned and filled pool, add 1 fluid ounce of Algaecide 60 per 10,000 gallons of water. Subsequent treatments should be made every 5 to 7 days after initial treatment for maintenance.

Spas, whirlpools, or hot tubs having just visible algae growth, add 2 fluid ounces of Algaecide 60 per 1,000 gallons of water. For hot tubs, add 1 fluid ounce of Algaecide 60 per 1,000 gallons of water. Subsequent treatments should be made every 5 to 7 days after initial treatment for maintenance.

Algaecide 60 is compatible with those chemicals normally used in swimming pools and is effective at both acid and alkaline pH. Algaecide 60 should be used in conjunction with chlorine chemicals and may require additional chlorine products.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Keep container closed when not in use. Do not use for storage, disposal or cleaning of equipment. If damaged containers should be placed in a plastic bag and up spills with clear water. All pesticides should be kept stored away from food.

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL: Pesticide wastes are acutely toxic. Do not dispose of excess pesticide, spray mixture, or rinsate in the environment. If these wastes cannot be disposed of by use according to label directions, your state Pesticide or Environmental Control Agency representative at the nearest EPA Regional Office for guidance.

CONTAINER DISPOSAL: Do not reuse empty container. Wrap in several layers of newspaper before discarding. Then offer for puncture and dispose of in a sanitary landfill or incinerator, if permitted by local authorities, by burning. If burned, stay out of smoke.

GENERAL: Consult Federal, state or local disposal authority for procedures such as limited open burning.
