For maximum effectiveness, pools, spas, whirlpools and hot tubs containing heavy growth of algae should be cleaned prior to using [this product] {or} [brand name]. For pools having just visible algae growth, add an initial dose of 23.5 to 36.4 fluid ounces of [this product]{or} [brand name] per 10,000 gallons of water and remove settled algae debris by cleaning. For treatment of freshly cleaned and filled pool, add initially 12.8 to 23.5 fluid ounces of [this product] {or} [brand name] per 10,000 gallons of water. Subsequent additions of 4.3 to 8.6 fluid ounces of this product per 10,000 gallons of water must be made every 5 to 7 days after initial treatment for maintenance. Spas, whirlpools and hot tubs having just visible signs of algae growth require an initial dose of 2 to 4 fluid ounces of this product] {or} [brand name] per 1,000 gallons of water.

For pools which have been properly treated during the swimming season and are free of visible algae, add 13.3 to 24 fluid ounces of [this product]{or} [brand name] per 10,000 gallons of water.

If the pool is not covered, it may be necessary to repeat treatment one or two more times throughout the winter months.
