Based on a review of the material submitted the Notification is not acceptable. The addition of unrelated sanitize and shock/oxidize steps is misleading since your proposed language doesn't reference the need to follow directions on the other products. The alternate name should state it is Step 3.

For maximum effectiveness pools spas whirlpools and hot tubs containing heavy growth of algae should be cleaned prior to using [this product] {or} [brand name]. For pools having just visible algae growth, add an initial dose of 23.5 to 36.4 fluid ounces of [this product] {or} [brand name] per 10.000 gallons of water and remove settled algae debris by cleaning. For treatment of freshly cleaned and filled pool, add initially 12.8 to 23.5 fluid ounces of [this product] {or} [brand name] per 10.000 gallons of water. Subsequent additions of 4.3 to 8.6 fluid ounces of this product per 10.000 gallons of water must be made every 5 to 7 days after initial treatment for maintenance.
