[This product] {or} [brand name] is used to control the growth of algae in swimming pools, exterior spas, whirlpools, and hot tubs. For maximum effectiveness, pools, spas, whirlpools and hot tubs containing heavy growth of algae must be cleaned prior to using [this product] {or} [brand name].

For pools having just visible algae growth, add an initial dose of 13 to 24 fluid ounces of [this product] {or} [brand name] per 10,000 gallons of water and remove settled algae debris by cleaning.

For treatment of freshly cleaned and filled pool, add initially 12.8 to 23.5 fluid ounces of [this product] {or} [brand name] per 10,000 gallons of water. Subsequent additions of 4.3 to 8.6 fluid ounces of this product per 10,000 gallons of water must be made every 5 to 7 days after initial treatment for maintenance. Spas, whirlpools and hot tubs having just visible signs of algae growth require an initial dose of 2 to 4 fluid ounces of this product] {or} [brand name] per 1,000 gallons of water.
