g. Revise the Environmental Hazards statement to read:

Environmental Hazards



INITIAL APPLICATION (To A Clean Pool): Add 4 quarts of Algaecide 10 to the pool. If algae growth is visible, apply the initial dose. Remove dead algae. If algae is still visible repeat dose as needed.

CONTINUED APPLICATION: Add one quart of Algaecide 10 to the pool 3-5 days or as needed to maintain 2 ppm active. Quaternary Ammonium Chloride.

BOOSTER APPLICATION: Add one quart of Algaecide 10 to the pool 3-5 days or as needed to maintain 2 ppm active. Quaternary Ammonium Chloride.

If algae growth is noticeable, apply the initial dose.

The above directions should be followed even when the pool is being treated with other chemicals.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE INSTRUCTIONS: Store in original container. Keep from freezing. Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal.

SPILL OR LEAK PROCEDURE: Small spills may be mop up and absorb on some absorbent material and incinerated.

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL: Securely wrap original container and discard in trash.

CONTAINER DISPOSAL: Do not reuse container (bottle, can, etc.) for other purposes. Discard in trash.

GENERAL: Consult Federal, state or local disposal authorities for disposal of this product.
