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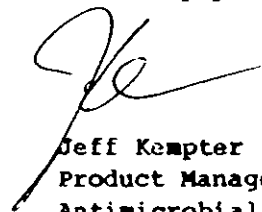

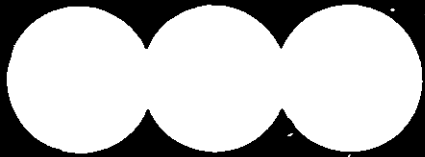

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

GENERAL CLASSIFICATION

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with labeling.

Poly-Algaecide 50 is used to control the growth of algae in swimming pools, spas, whirlpools, hot tubs, and decorative fountains. Algae should be cleaned prior to using Poly-Algaecide 50.

For pools having just visible algae growth add 1.3 fluid ounces of Poly-Algaecide 50 per 10,000 gallons of water. For treatment of a freshly cleaned pool, add 2.5 to 4.9 fluid ounces of Poly-Algaecide 50 per 10,000 gallons of water. Subsequent additions of 0.3 to 0.5 fluid ounces of Poly-Algaecide 50 should be made every 5 to 7 days after initial treatment.

For spas, whirlpools, hot tubs, or decorative fountains, require an initial dose of 1 to 2 fluid ounces of Poly-Algaecide 50 per 1,000 gallons of water. For treatment of a freshly cleaned and filled decorative fountain, add initially 0.7 to 1.3 fluid ounces of Poly-Algaecide 50 per 1,000 gallons of water. Subsequent additions of 0.3 to 0.5 fluid ounces of Poly-Algaecide 50 should be made every 5 to 7 days after initial treatment.

Poly-Algaecide 50 is compatible with those chemicals used in pools and spas treated with chlorine chemicals. Poly-Algaecide 50 is effective at both acid and alkaline pH levels. However, concentrated dry or liquid chlorine products.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL
