STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT (FIRST AID): If swallowed, promptly take a large quantity of milk, egg whites, gelatin solution, or if these are not available, drink large quantities of water. Avoid alcohol. Call a physician immediately.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS: This pesticide is toxic to fish. Keep out of streams or ponds. Permits may be required for discharges containing this product into lakes, streams, ponds, or public water. For guidance, contact the regional office of the Environmental Protection Agency.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with labeling.

Poly-Algaecide 50 is used to control the growth of algae in swimming pools, spas, whirlpools, hot tubs, and decorative fountains. For maximum effectiveness, clean pools, spas, whirlpools, hot tubs and decorative fountains containing algae before using Poly-Algaecide 50.

For pools having just visible algae growth add an initial dose of 13.5 to 27 fluid ounces of Poly-Algaecide 50 per 10,000 gallons of water and remove sediment by cleaning. For treatment of a freshly cleaned and tiled pool add 13.5 fluid ounces of Poly-Algaecide 50 per 10,000 gallons of water. Subsequent additions of 2.5 to 4.9 fluid ounces of Poly-Algaecide 50 per 10,000 gallons of water should be made every 5 to 7 days after initial treatment for maintenance.

Spas, whirlpools, hot tubs, or decorative fountains having just visible algae growth require an initial dose of 1 to 2 fluid ounces of Poly-Algaecide 50 per 1,000 gallons of water. For treatment of a freshly cleaned and tiled spa, whirlpool, hot tub, or decorative fountain, add initially 0.7 to 1.3 fluid ounces of Poly-Algaecide 50 per 1,000 gallons of water. Subsequent additions of 0.3 to 0.5 fluid ounces of Poly-Algaecide 50 should be made every 5 to 7 days after initial treatment for maintenance.

Poly-Algaecide 50 is compatible with those chemicals normally used in pools and spas and is effective at both acid and alkaline pH. Poly-Algaecide 50 should not be used in pools and spas treated with chlorine chemicals and may reduce the effectiveness of those chemicals normally required. However, do not mix Poly-Algaecide 50 with concentrated dry or liquid chlorine products.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Keep container closed when not in use. Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage, disposal or cleaning of equipment. Residue that cannot be removed should be disposed of in a landfill approved for pesticides. Incineration is prohibited.

METAL CONTAINERS: Triple rinse and offer for recycling, or recode, or dispose in approved landfill area.

PLASTIC CONTAINERS: Do not reuse empty container. Triple rinse, or recode, or dispose of in an approved landfill area.
