HAZARDS TO HUMAN AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

CAUTION: Harmful if swallowed. Avoid breathing vapors. Avoid contact with skin, eyes, or clothing.

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT (FIRST AID):

If swallowed: Rinse mouth with large amounts of water. Then drink 3 to 4 glasses of water. Do not induce vomiting. Avoid alcohol. Call a physician immediately.
If in eyes: Flush with plenty of water for 15 minutes. Get medical attention.
If on skin: Wash with plenty of soap and water. If irritation persists, get medical attention.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS: This pesticide is toxic to fish. Keep out of lake streams or ponds. Permits may be required for discharges containing this pesticide into lakes, streams, ponds, or public water. For guidance, contact the regional office of the Environmental Protection Agency.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with labeling.

This product is used to control the growth of algae in swimming pools, exterior spa whirlpools, hot tubs, and decorative fountains. For maximum effectiveness, pool spas, whirlpools, hot tubs and decorative fountains containing heavy growth algae should be cleaned prior to using this product.

For pools having just visible algae growth add an initial dose of 13.5 to 21 fluid ounces of this product per 10,000 gallons of water and remove settled algae debris. For treatment of a freshly cleaned and filled pool add initially 7.4 to 13 fluid ounces of this product per 10,000 gallons of water. Subsequent additions of 2 to 4 fluid ounces of this product per 10,000 gallons of water should be made every 5 to 7 days after initial treatment for maintenance.

Spas, whirlpools, hot tubs, or decorative fountains having just visible algae growth require an initial dose of 1 to 2 fluid ounces of this product per 1,000 gallons of water. For treatment of a freshly cleaned and filled spa, whirlpool, hot tub, or decorative fountain, add initially 0.7 to 1.3 fluid ounces of this product per 1,000 gallons of water. Subsequent additions of 0.3 to 0.5 fluid ounces of this product should be made every 5 to 7 days after initial treatment for maintenance.

This product is compatible with those chemicals normally used to treat pools or spas and is effective at both acid and alkaline pH. This product can be used in pools and spas treated with chlorine chemicals and may reduce the amount of those chemicals normally required. However, do not mix this product with concentrated dry or liquid chlorine products.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Keep container closed when not in use. Do not contaminate water, food, or feed. Storage, disposal or cleaning of equipment. Residue that cannot be used or processed should be disposed of in a landfill approved for pesticides. Open dumping is prohibited.

METAL CONTAINERS: Triple rinse and offer for recycling, reconditioning, or disposal in approved landfill area.

PLASTIC CONTAINERS: Do not reuse empty container. Triple rinse and change or dispose of in an approved landfill area.
