1. Delete "... milk, egg whites, gelatin solution, or if these are not available, drink large quantities of . . . ."
2. Delete "non-metallic" in the second paragraph under "Directions For Use." Comparison claims of this nature are unacceptable.

Submit five (5) copies of the final printed label.

Poly-Algazine 30-35 is a fast-acting, non-  
selective algicide that effectively kills most types of algae found in  
swimming pools. It is compatible with those chemicals normally  
used in swimming pools. It can be used in pools with  
acid and alkaline pH. It can be used in pools  
intended as a substitute for chlorine sanitizers.  
Concentrated dry or liquid chlorine products.

1. Shake well before using.  
2. Use the dosage appropriate for your pool.  
Initial treatment of a freshly filled pool:  
Add 8 to 12 fluid ounces of Poly-Algazine 30-35 per 10,000 gallons of water.

Initial treatment of a pool with visible  
algae: Add 16 to 24 fluid ounces of Poly-Algazine 30-35 for every 10,000  
gallons of water. After 24 hours, vacuum the pool floor, then remove by vacuum.  
Algae should be cleaned prior to use.

Maintenance dose: Subsequent addition
