#### **General Comment:**

1. Revise the Storage and Disposal Statement to read:

#### Storage and Disposal

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal

**Pesticide Storage**: Keep this product...before discarding this container. Delete the sentence "Do not contaminate food or feed by storage or disposal"

2. The following statement must be included in the precautionary statement, "wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling".

A stamped copy of the accepted labeling is enclosed. Submit three (3) copies of your final printed labeling before distributing or selling the product.

Algaezone Plus provides effective control of algae growth in all types of swimming pools. Even though it affords long term algae control, periodic additions on a scheduled basis will assure fasting algae control. Treated water may be used immediately after addition of Algaezone Plus. Algaezone Plus is designed to prevent the growth of swimming pool algae.

Dilute Algaezone Plus with at least nine parts of water and sprinkle around edge of pool. Add additional amounts of

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Algaezone Plus every two weeks in accordance to directions on the chart.

For best results, begin pool maintenance with Algaezone Plus when the pool is first filled with water. Add according to the size of pool as given in the chart below:

FOR CIRCULAR OR ELIPTICAL POOLS: L X W X D X 5.9 = GALLONS

#### STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Keep this product dry in original tightly closed container when not in use. Store in a cool, dry, well ventilated area away from heat or open flame. Moisture may decompose this product and cause a violent reaction leading to fire and explosion. In case of decomposition, isolate container if possible and flood area: with large volumes of water to dissolve all material before discalding this container. Do not contaminate food or feed by storage or disposal.
