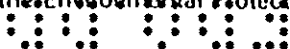

Olympic Spa Algaecide

in swimming pools, exterior spas, whirlpools, hot tubs, and decorative fountain effectiveness pools, spas, whirlpools, hot tubs, and decorative fountains. Heavy growth of algae should be cleaned prior to treatment.

For pools having just visible algae growth, add 1 fluid ounces of Olympic Spa Algaecide per 10,000 gallons of water. For pools with moderate to heavy algae growth, move settled algae debris by cleaning. For pools with heavy algae growth, per pool add initially 41 to 75 fluid ounces of Olympic Spa Algaecide per 10,000 gallons of water. Subsequent additions of Olympic Spa Algaecide should be made every 7 days after initial treatment for maintenance.

Spas, whirlpools, hot tubs, or decorative fountains should require an initial dose of 8 to 12 fluid ounces per 1000 gallons of water. For treatment of hot tubs, or decorative fountain, add initially 1 to 3 fluid ounces of Olympic Spa Algaecide per 1000 gallons of water. Additions of Olympic Spa Algaecide should be made every 5 to 7 days after initial treatment.

Olympic Spa Algaecide should be used to treat pools and spas and is not to be used in conjunction with chlorine chemicals and may reduce the effectiveness of chlorine. However, do not mix Olympic Spa Algaecide with liquid chlorine products.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Keep container closed and tightly sealed. Containers should be placed in a plastic bag and stored with clear water. All pesticides should be stored away from food.

DISPOSAL: Do not reuse empty containers.
