Spa Algaecide is used to control the growth of algae in maximum effectiveness, spas and hot tubs containing should be cleaned prior to using Spa Algaecide.

For open and hot tubs having just visible algae growth, add 1 fluid ounce of Spa Algaecide per 500 gallons of water, freshly cleaned and filled spa or hot tub add initially 2 to 4 fluid ounces of Spa Algaecide per 500 gallons of water. Subsequent additions of Spa Algaecide per 500 gallons of water should be made 1 to 2 weeks after initial treatment for maintenance.

Spee Algaecide is compatible with those chemicals normally used in spas and hot tubs and is effective as both acid and alkaline. It can be used in spas and hot tubs treated with chlorine chemistry. The amount of those chemicals normally required. However, Algaecide with concentrated dry or liquid chlorine products.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Keep container closed when not in use. Containers should be placed in a plastic bag and discarded with clear water. All pesticides should be kept out of stored away from food.
