Use JACK FROST WINTERIZER in swimming pools, exterior spas, whirlpools, hot tubs, and ponds that do not contain fish. For maximum effectiveness in decorative fountains, and ponds containing heavy growth of algae, use JACK FROST WINTERIZER to using JACK FROST WINTERIZER.

For pools having just visible algae growth add an initial dose of 4 fluid ounces of JACK FROST WINTERIZER per 10,000 gallons of water. To remove settled algae debris by cleaning. For treatment of algae in swimming pools, add initially 20 to 37 fluid ounces of JACK FROST WINTERIZER per 10,000 gallons of water. Subsequent additions of 4 fluid ounces of JACK FROST WINTERIZER per 10,000 gallons of water every 7 to 10 days after initial treatment for maintenance.

Spas, whirlpools, hot tubs, decorative fountains, and ponds containing algae growth require an initial dose of 4 fluid ounces of JACK FROST WINTERIZER per 1000 gallons of water. Subsequent additions of 1 fluid ounce of JACK FROST WINTERIZER per 1000 gallons of water should be made for maintenance.
