

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. When used as directed, POWER SHOCK PLUS will destroy green algae and cyanobacteria (blue-green algae) on most water surfaces. Turn off filter pump and brush away floating algae vigorously. Allow the pool water to become still. For heavy algae growth, add 1 pound per 10,000 gallons of water by sprinkling material where algae growth appears—start in the water's surface and work toward the pool walls. Turn the pump back on after six hours. Do not continue use until the algae residue is less than 1 ppm. Remove dead algae after treatment is complete the next morning, by brushing or scraping. If visible living algae still exists after brushing, repeat treatment with POWER SHOCK PLUS.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Store in original container. Store in a dry place. Do not allow water to get into container. Keep it well closed. Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal. Keep from freezing.

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL: Pesticide wastes are acutely hazardous. Improper disposal of excess pesticide, spray mixture, or residue is a violation of Federal law. If these wastes cannot be disposed of by use according to label instructions, contact your State Pesticide or Environmental Control Agency, or the Hazardous Waste representative at the nearest EPA Regional Office for guidance.

PRACTICAL TREATMENT (FIRST AID)

If swallowed, do not induce vomiting. Drink water or milk. If vomiting occurs, do not induce it. If in eyes, flush with plenty of water for 15 minutes. If on skin, immediately flush with plenty of water for 15 minutes. If on clothing, remove clothing and flush with water.

If inhaled, remove person to fresh air. If breathing is difficult, give artificial respiration. If unconscious, give artificial respiration.

Note to the physician: In case of emergency, contact the nearest hospital or poison control center.

PHYSICAL AND CHEMICAL HAZARDS: Strong oxidizing agent. Will burn with the evolution of chlorine and equally toxic gases. Contact with moisture liberates irritating and hazardous chlorine containing gases. Decomposes at 460°F to 480°F with liberation of harmful gases.

Mix only with water. Use clean dry utensils. Do not add this product to any dispensing device containing remnants of any other product. Such use may cause a violent reaction and might lead to explosion. Contamination with moisture, organic matter, or other chemicals may start a chemical reaction with generation of fire and explosion.

In case of fire, if possible isolate container in open area well ventilated area. Flush with large volumes of water.

In case of contamination or decomposition, do not breathe vapor.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS: This pesticide is extremely toxic to fish and other aquatic life. Do not discharge effluent containing this product into lakes, streams, ponds, or other waters unless this product is specifically identified and addressed in an NPDES permit. Do not discharge effluent containing this product into sewer systems unless previously notifying the sewage treatment plant. Do not discharge effluent into the water body or the ground.

SPILL: Sweep up and dispose of in a safe manner. Do not allow to enter water. Flush with water.
