1. Include the "Environmental Hazards" heading before the paragraph beginning with the statement "This pesticide is toxic to fish."
2. In the same paragraph, revise the statement "Do not contaminate water by wastes" to read "Do not contaminate water when disposing of equipment washwaters".

Keep out of streams. Permits may be required for discharges containing this pesticide into public waters.

SPECIAL PRECAUTIONS

1. This product has a powerful chlorine odor. Hold away from face when opening.
2. Prolonged contact between this product in its undissolved state and vinyl floors or in breathing of the vinyl or paint, introduce this product through the swimmer or avoid disintegration of floor or paint.
3. When adding this product to skimmer or feeder, make sure there are no other chemicals. Reaction may occur. It is always dangerous to mix chemicals.
4. Use this product as directed as per instructions on label. Do not take advice from yourself.
5. If this product is used to shock or superchlorinate a pool, after treatment, it is important to expose areas that may be in cracks or wrinkles that might protect algae from. Such protected areas will begin to reproduce again when high chlorine residues are gone.
6. This product, because of its potent formulation, can be dangerous if not used as directed. Do not add this product to a small amount of water in a pail or to a skimmer. Make sure pumps on and water is circulating so that material is drawn. Do not allow the top of dry material in skimmer as gases generated may cause explosion.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

This is a water soluble granular to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its label. The pH of the water should be adjusted to 7.4-7.6 before applying this product. When using in a pool, apply immediately then allow pool water to become slightly acidic. When the pH is below 7.0, the product will be more effective. When algae growth appears, both in and out of pool, use 14 ounces per 10,000 gallons of water. For heavy algae growth use 14 ounces per 10,000 gallons of water. Do not use pool or hot tubs as determined by a suitable test kit.

Twelve to twenty-four hours after treatment, remove dead algae growth by brushing or vacuuming. Repeat treatment after brushing or repeat treatment with this product.

DO NOT USE THIS PRODUCT IN PAINTED, VINYL LINED, FIBERGLASS OR SURFACE POOLS

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Keep product dry in original container when not in use. Store in a cool, dry, well-ventilated place. Keep contents and container dry and off wet floors. In case of spill, absorb with large amounts of water to dissolve all material. Transfer to a suitable container for disposal. Wrap container and place in trash and dispose of properly.

This product is a restricted use pesticide and should not be distributed where it will be sold to the general public. Do not contaminate water by cleaning of equipment or disposal of this pesticide or its container.
