

SPECIAL PRECAUTIONS

- 1. This product has a powerful chlorine odor. Hold away from face when opening to avoid breathing fumes.
- 2. Use the product as instructed on the label. Do not take advice from others or experiment by yourself.
- 3. This product, because of its potent formulation, can be dangerous if not used properly. Do not mix with any other chemicals. Doing so could lead result in a violent chemical reaction. Do not add water to this product in a closed container. Do not add water to this product in a small amount of water in a pail.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

INITIAL DOSAGE: The pH of the pool water should be adjusted to 7.4 to 7.6 before applying this product. For light algae growth, use 7 ounces per 10,000-gallons of water. For heavy algae growth, use 14 ounces per 10,000-gallons of water. Twelve to twenty-four hours after

treatment, remove dead algae growth by brushing or scraping. Expose algae in cracks or wrinkles which may have been protected from the high chlorine residual. It will begin to reproduce again as the chlorine residual falls. If living algae is still visible after brushing, repeat treatment.

NOTE: Re-entry into treated swimming pool is prohibited above levels of 3.0 ppm of chlorine.

Use one of the following methods of application:

SKIMMER METHOD: Use this method to avoid bleaching vinyl liner, fiberglass or paint. Empty skimmer of all chemicals and debris. Make sure that pump and filter are on and that water is properly recirculating through skimmer. Remove any chemicals that may be in an in-line automatic feeder. Pour this product slowly into skimmer, making sure that the material is drawn into the system at the same rate. Do not allow this material to accumulate as gases generated may cause an explosion.

BROADCAST METHOD: Shut off filter pump, brush wall-clinging algae vigorously, then allow pool water to become stationary. Broadcast over surface of water where algae growth appears in the evening or when the pool is not in use. Use skimmer method to prevent bleaching of colored surfaces.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Keep this product dry in original tightly closed container when not in use. Store in a cool, dry, well ventilated area away from heat or open flame. Moisture may decompose this product and cause a violent reaction leading to fire and explosion. In case of decomposition, isolate container if possible and flood area with large volumes of water to dissolve all material before discarding this container. Do not contaminate food or feed by storage or disposal.

CONTAINER DISPOSAL: Do not reuse container, but place in trash collection. Rinse thoroughly before discarding.
