Wait 15 minutes after adding chlorine. 7. Add this product through skimmer at the rate of 8 ounces every 10 minutes until recommended dosage is reached. If pool has no skimmer, add this product below water level in front of return by squeezing bottle at the same rate mentioned above. 8. Keep filter in operation during treatment and for a minimum of 72 hours after treatment. 9. For best results, keep filter in operation until condition

This product is not intended for winterizing pools.
