Dear Mr. Ramsey:

This is in response to your justification for EPA acceptance of the inclusion of certain items in the product labeling that were not accepted in the Agency's letter dated August 18, 1995. These items are medical trays, toothbrush handles, toothbrush bristles, toys for children under five years of age, cutting boards, counter tops, and containers for cosmetics. (An additional item, medical gloves, was not addressed in the subject submission.)

The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is being re-accepted subject to the shortened set of comments below. A stamped copy of the labeling is enclosed for your records.

1. In the words "Gloves (consumer, Medical)," delete the word "Medical".

2. Submit five copies of the finished labeling before the product is released for shipment bearing the amended labeling.

In any future labeling amendments, submit the complete product labeling - include the basic label.
