e. Revise the Directions for Use statement to read:


See the leaflet enclosed with the water filter for the directions for use.

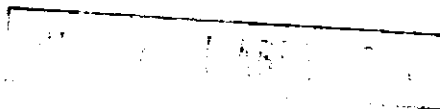
