NET CONTENTS

— GALLON

To Kill Spiders or Cockroaches
Spray directly onto spiders and cockroaches and their harborage areas. Do not spray on food or food handling equipment. Petals blown off during spraying should not be sprayed directly. Treatment is residual power of spray. Repeat treatment as necessary.

To Kill Carpet Beetles

Spray edges of carpeting and under carpeting and rug. Make localized application to the floor and baseboards. Spray directly onto carpet edges and in treated areas of carpeting repeat as necessary.

To Kill Bed Bugs, Fleas

Thoroughly spray carpet, furniture, clothing, curtains, blinds, and other household items and doorknobs, etc. Coverage Application: — Other reported as necessary. Fresh bedding can be placed in a plastic bag and sprayed where these insects are found or congregating.

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

Extinguisher: Call Fire Department or Poison Control Center immediately. Gaseous fumes are released if container is heated internally. DO NOT INDUCE VOMITING. Vomiting may cause aspiration pneumonia.

Inhalation: Remove victim from heat. Apply artificial respiration if indicated.

Non-Utter: Remove contaminated clothing and wash affected areas with soap and water.

In Eyes: Flush eyes with plenty of water. Get medical attention if irritation persists.
