This product is conditionally registered in accordance with FIFRA sec. 3(c)(7)(A) provided that you:



DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Polar Bear is used in swimming pools, exterior spas, whirlpools, hot tubs, and minimum effectiveness pools, spas, whirlpools, hot tubs, and decorative fountains. Heavy growth of algae should be cleaned prior to using Polar Bear. For pools having just visible algae growth add an initial dose of 6 fluid ounces of Polar Bear per 10,000 gallons of water. Move settled algae debris by cleaning. For treatment of pools with heavy growth of algae add initially 6 to 11 fluid ounces of Polar Bear per 10,000 gallons of water. Subsequent additions of 2 fluid ounces of Polar Bear per 10,000 gallons of water should be made every 5 to 7 days after initial treatment for maintenance.

Spas, whirlpools, hot tubs, and decorative fountains having heavy growth of algae require an initial dose of 1 to 2 fluid ounces of Polar Bear per 1000 gallons of water. For treatment of a freshly cleaned hot tub, or decorative fountain, add initially 0.6 fluid ounces of Polar Bear per 1,000 gallons of water. Subsequent additions of 0.2 to 0.4 fluid ounces of Polar Bear should be made every 5 to 7 days after initial treatment for maintenance. Polar Bear is compatible with chlorine. Polar Bear can be used to treat pools, spas, and decorative fountains and is compatible with alkaline pH. Polar Bear can be used in decorative fountains treated with chlorine chemicals and may replace the chlorine chemicals normally required. However, do not mix Polar Bear with concentrated dry or liquid chlorine products.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Keep container closed when not in use. Containers should be placed in a plastic bag and discarded with clear water. All pesticides should be kept out of reach of children and away from food.

DISPOSAL: Do not reuse empty container. Wrap container in plastic.
