DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling

IMPORTANT NOTES

- Do not mix Sparkling Spa Algaecide with concentrated chlorine products
- Always adjust spa maintenance according to frequency of use, bather load, sunlight exposure and temperature

DOSAGE

- Ensure all spa equipment is working properly, including pump, filter, skimmer and heater prior to adding any water treatment chemicals
- Using recommended procedure, backwash spa's filter
- Maintain water pH at 7.4-7.6 for at least 6 hours before adding Sparkling Spa Algaecide (Adjust pH with Sparkling Spa pH Increaser or pH Decreaser)
- For spas, whirlpools and hot tubs having just visible algae growth, add 10 to 15 fluid ounces of Sparkling Spa Algaecide per 1,000 gallons of water. Recirculate water for one hour for maximum performance
- For freshly cleaned spa, whirlpool or hot tub, use 4-8 fluid ounces of Sparkling Spa Algaecide per 1,000 gallons of water. Subsequent additions of 2 to 5 fluid ounces of algaecide should be used every 5-7 days
- Recheck pH and adjust if needed

Precautions: Hazards to humans and domestic animals.

Caution: Harmful if swallowed. Avoid breathing vapors. Avoid contact with eyes and clothing.

First Aid: If swallowed promptly drink large quantities of milk, egg white gelatin solution or if these are not available, drink large quantities of water. Avoid alcohol. Call a physician immediately.

Storage and Disposal: Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal. Store in a locked, cool, dry, well ventilated area away from heat and open flames. Map up spills with clear water. DO NOT reuse container. Rinse container and put in trash collection.

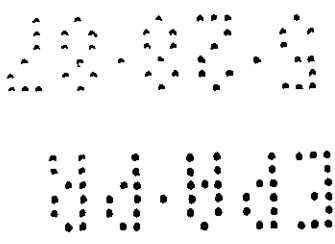
