COOLING TOWERS: Wood Preservative cooling tower wood against soft or surface rot and insecting or painting a dispersion containing 0.5 to 0.7% Wood Preservative in water onto the clean wood surfaces. The amount Wood Preservative per 1000

rot can also be inhibited by periodic shock doses of Wood Preservative to the recirculating cooling water at the tower basin. Provide 1.25 lb. of Wood Preservative bleedoff should be stopped for 4 to 6 hr. after treatment repeated every four months.
