

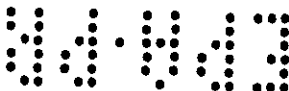
Select the proper dilution of **THIS PRODUCT** for your use from the directions below. Apply the use solution with a clean mop, sponge, cloth, squeegee, or mechanical scrubber.

Prepare fresh use solutions daily. Do not reuse solutions. Discard solutions when they become visibly soiled. For disinfection, thoroughly wet the surfaces to be treated. Surfaces must remain moist for at least 10 minutes to assure proper germicidal action.

This product may be used for cleaning and disinfecting hard, non-porous, inanimate environmental surfaces (glass, metal, glazed porcelain, linoleum, tile, smooth leather, vinyl, enameled and finished wood surfaces) on walls, floors, appliances and furnishings.

**CLEANING**

To Clean and Deodorize or to Pre-clean Prior to Disinfection. Depending on the soil level of the area to be cleaned, use 2 to 6 oz. of **THIS PRODUCT** per gallon of water.

When applied as directed to pre-cleaned hard, non-porous surfaces, this disinfectant also kills the following organisms at 3 ounces per gallon: *Candida albicans*, *Escherichia coli*, *Streptococcus pyogenes*, *Enterobacter aerogenes*, *Shigella sonnei*.

**DISINFECTANT**

Hospitals, Veterinary Clinics: 32 parts water) for one-step of areas with light to medium soiled areas, pre-clean as disinfect with **THIS PRODUCT** part to 41 parts water).

Industrial areas, Barber Shop, Food and Meat Processing areas, Other Non-Medical areas. Then, disinfect with a solution of **THIS PRODUCT** in a gallon of water. Alternatively, clean and disinfect with **THIS PRODUCT** in 33 parts water).

For deodorizing garbage cans, waste receptacles, and gutters is especially important to perform properly. Then, disinfect with 1/2 oz. of **THIS PRODUCT**.

For mildew control: For disinfection. Repeat treatment when new growth appears.

**THIS PRODUCT** may be used for scrubbing equipment.

**THIS PRODUCT** must be used on all surfaces.
