

A stamped copy of the label is enclosed for your records.



DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with the label. POOLCIDE 40 is used in swimming pools, exterior spas, whirlpools, hot tubs, etc. that do not contain fish. For maximum effectiveness pool decorative fountains, and ponds containing heavy growth of algae to using POOLCIDE 40.

For pools having just visible algae growth add an initial fluid ounces of POOLCIDE 40 per 10,000 gallons of water. To remove settled algae debris by cleaning. For treatment of algae add initially 9 to 17 fluid ounces of POOLCIDE 40 per 10,000 gallons of water. Subsequent additions of 3 POOLCIDE 40 per 10,000 gallons of water 7 to 10 days after initial treatment for maintenance.

Spas, whirlpools, hot tubs, decorative fountains, and ponds with algae growth require an initial dose of 2 to 4 fluid ounces of POOLCIDE 40 per 1000 gallons of water. Subsequent additions of 0.3 to 0.5 fluid ounces of POOLCIDE 40 should be made every 2 to 3 days for maintenance.

POOLCIDE 40 will prevent algae growth during the off-season winter months when pools are not in use. Pools regularly treated during the swimming season and are free of algae should be treated with 16 fluid ounces of algicide per 10,000 gallons of water. Season pools have some visible algae growth, add 19 fluid ounces of POOLCIDE 40 per 10,000 gallons. It is necessary that a uniform distribution of water and the pool be made for maximum effectiveness. Repeat the treatment one or more times during the season.

POOLCIDE 40 is compatible with other pool chemicals used to treat pools and spas and is effective against algae. POOLCIDE 40 can be used in conjunction with chlorine chemicals and may reduce the amount of chlorine required. However, do not mix POOLCIDE 40 with other chlorine products.

STORAGE & DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Do not contaminate water, food, or feed. Keep container closed when not in use. Leaking or broken containers should be placed in a plastic bag and discarded in trash. All pesticides should be kept out of reach of children.

DISPOSAL: Do not reuse empty container. Wrap or dispose of in accordance with local, state, and federal regulations.
