On the basis of information furnished by the registrant, the above named pesticide is hereby registered/reregistered under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act.

Registration is in no way to be construed as an endorsement or recommendation of this product by the Agency. In order to protect health and the environment, the Administrator, on his motion, may at any time suspend or cancel the registration of a pesticide in accordance with the Act. The acceptance of any name in connection with the registration of a product under this Act is not to be construed as giving the registrant a right to exclusive use of the name or to its use if it has been covered by others.

This product is conditionally registered in accordance with FIFRA sec. 3(c)(7)(A) since:

1. You agreed to revise your method of data support from selected method to cite all. Mclaughlin Gormley King Company (MGK) has submitted efficacy data (MRID 437510-01) for esfenvalerate on fire ants in support of your registration. These data are currently waiting review. You may be required to make labeling changes and MGK may be required to submit additional information/data if review of the data indicate such action. After MGK's efficacy data is reviewed and accepted you will have the option of returning to "selective method."

2. And provided that you submit and/or cite all data required for registration/ reregistration of your product under FIFRA sec. 3(c)(5) when the Agency requires all registrants of similar products to submit such data; and submit acceptable responses required for reregistration of your product under FIFRA section 4.

3. Make the following label changes:

a. Revise the EPA Registration Number to read, "EPA Reg. No. 42389-20".

- b. Delete your current directions for use, including the heading "To Kill Fire Ants in their Mounds" and replace with the following: "Fire Ants: To kill foraging fire ants in lawns and ornamental turf, use 2 2/3 fluid ounces of concentrate in 6 gallons of water in a hose-end sprayer to cover 1000 square feet (50' X 20'). Put concentrate in sprayer jar and then add water to the 6 gallon mark. Gently swirl to mix the concentrate in the water. Attach sprayer jar with sprayer in the "off" position. Turn on water and spray, using a slow, even motion to give even coverage. Spray under ornamentals and trees, avoiding young or flowering plants. Repeat treatment in 7 to 14 days. Spray entire lawn; do not spot spray."
- c. Since the MGK efficacy data supports kill of foraging ants only and not mounds make the following changes to front and back panels:
- (1) Revise the phrases "Kills Fireants" and "Fire Ant Killer Treatment" to:

"Aids in Control of Fireants"

"Fire AntKiller Treatment in lawns and ornamental turf."
 - (2) Delete "Kills Fire Ants in their Mounds."
 - (3) On back panel revise the "For Outdoor Use Only" paragraph to read:

"To aid in the control of fire ants in lawns, yards, parks, woodlands, playground and similar outdoor areas."
- d. The data support use of this product as a hose-end sprayer. Your product must be modified for use with this type spray attachment.
- e. Revise Precautionary Statements as follows: "Harmful if swallowed, absorbed through skin or inhaled, causes moderate eye irritation. Contains petroleum distillate. Do not induce vomiting because of aspiration pneumonia hazard. Avoid breathing vapor or spray mist and contact with skin, eyes or clothing. In case of contact, flush with plenty of water. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling. Remove contaminated clothing and wash before reuse. Obtain medical attention if irritation persists. Avoid contamination of food or feedstuffs."
- f. Revise the Environmental Hazards statement to read as follows: "This product is highly toxic to fish and other aquatic organisms. Do not apply direct to water. Do not contaminate water when disposing of equipment washwaters."

g. Your product contains only one active ingredient.
Therefore singularize the term "Active Ingredients."

3. Submit two copies of the revised final printed label for the record.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA sec. 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

A stamped copy of the label is enclosed for your records.

For outdoor use only: To aid in the control of fire ants in lawns, playgrounds, golf courses and similar outdoor areas. To aid in the control of fire ants, apply to the top of the mound. Do NOT disturb mound. Fire ants are obtained when a small opening approximately 1/4 inch in diameter is made in the mound top. A measured quantity of this product should be placed in the opening. For large mounds the dosage should be increased. Do not disturb the mound more than necessary when obtaining the ants. The rate of this product varies with temperature. It may take from one to three weeks to kill all ants affected by excess moisture. Treatment should not be repeated until the mound is saturated with water. At normal temperatures (60-80°F) approximately one to eight hours. All applicable precautions on the label are to be followed. This product is for use at the time of pesticide application. For foot: Pour 2 liquid ounces into small hole in top of mound. For mound: Pour 2 liquid ounces into small hole in top of mound. Then pour 2 liquid ounces in to small hole in top of mound.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Store in a cool, dry place. Keep container tightly closed.
DISPOSAL: Do not reuse empty container. Wrap in newspaper and discard in trash.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

This product is toxic to fish and other wildlife. Do not apply where run-off is likely to occur. Do not use near water. Do not use on lawns or other areas where waste.
