Delete your current directions for use, including the heading "To Kill Fire Ants in their Mounds" and replace with the following: "Fire Ants: To kill foraging fire ants in lawns and ornamental turf, use 2 2/3 fluid ounces of concentrate in 6 gallons of water in a hose-end sprayer to cover 1000 square feet (50' X 20'). concentrate in sprayer jar and then add water to the 6 gallon mark. Gently swirl to mix the concentrate in the Attach sprayer jar with sprayer in the "off" position. Turn on water and spray, using a slow, even motion to give even coverage.
