### DIRECTIONS FOR USE GENERAL CLASSIFICATION

It is a violation of federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

**FOR SWIMMING POOLS:** For a new pool or for spring start up, super chlorinate with 1/2 pt. (8oz) of Starlight Sodium Hypochlorite Solution for each 1,000 gallons of water. This dosage is equivalent to 5 P.P.M. available chlorine by weight.

**NOTE:** This product degrades with age. Use a chlorine test kit and increase dosage, as necessary, to obtain the required level of available chlorine.

**STORAGE AND DISPOSAL:** Store in a cool, dry area away from direct sunlight. In case of spill, flood area with large quantities of water. Rinse empty container thoroughly with water and either return to manufacturer or discard by placing in trash collection or burying in an approved landfill. Product or rinsate that cannot be used, should be diluted with water and disposed of in a sanitary sewer. Do not contaminate food or feed by storage, disposal or cleaning of equipment.
