DANGER

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in manner inconsistent with its labeling. Do not apply this product in a way that will contact workers or other persons, either directly or through drift. Only protected handlers may be in the area during application. For any requirement of your State or Tribe, consult the agency responsible for pesticide regulation. The use of this product is restricted to lands west of the Mississippi River.

AGRICULTURAL USE REQUIREMENTS

Use this product only in accordance with its labeling and with the Worker Protection Standard, 40 CFR Part 170. This standard contains requirements for the protection of agricultural workers on farms, forests,, nurseries, and greenhouses, and handlers of agricultural pesticides. It contains requirements for training, decontamination, notification and emergency assistance. TO KILL POTATO VINES:

Apply undiluted 93% Sulphuric Acid at the rate of 17 - 28 gallons per acre, per application. Apply at least 5 days prior to harvest to allow tubers to mature. Repeat after 5 days if vines are not completely desiccated. Do not harvest within 5 days of application.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal. Contents may be under pressure of explosive hydrogen gas. Keep away from heat, sparks and flames. Do not add water to container because of violent reactions.

DISPOSAL: Pesticide wastes are acutely hazardous. Improper disposal of excess pesticide, spray mixture or rinsate is a violation of Federal law. If these wastes cannot be disposed by use according to label instructions, contact your State Pesticide or Environmental Control Agency or the hazardous waste representative at the nearest EPA Regional Office for guidance.
