areas where these pests may enter the home. Also spray dark corners and localized resting areas, such as under eaves, porches, partitions and in garages where these insects may congregate. Flies and mosquitoes coming to rest on treated surfaces will be killed. Repeat treatment when effectiveness diminishes.

To control cockroaches, ants, earwigs, water bugs, silverfish, spiders and crickets apply in small amounts directly into cracks and crevices using equipment capable of delivering a fine stream of insecticide. In particular, between different elements of construction, between equipment and floors, openings leading to voids and hollow spaces in walls, equipment legs and bases, in conduits, motor housings, junction or switch boxes. Prior to application de-energize electrical equipment. After application allow time for oil to evaporate before starting motor or placing switches in "ON" position. Care should be taken to avoid depositing the product on exposed surfaces or introducing the material into the air. Avoid contamination of food or food processing surfaces.

DISPOSAL

Do not reuse empty container. Wrap container and put in trash collection.

CAUTION

Do not spray air in rooms or use on plants. Apply as a surface spray only as specified on this label.
