DIRECTIONS FOR USE

FOOD HANDLING ESTABLISHMENTS: Places other than private residences in which exposed food is held, processed, prepared or served.

FOOD AREAS—APPLICATION LIMITED TO CRACK AND CREVICE TREATMENT ONLY.

Includes areas for receiving, storage, packing, unloading, wrapping, boxing, preparing, edible waste storage and enclosed processing systems (mills, dairies, edible oils, etc.) and serving areas (when food is exposed and facility is in operation).

To control roaches, ants, waterbugs, silverfish, spiders and crickets apply in small amounts directly into cracks and crevices using equipment capable of delivering a pin stream of insecticide, in points between different elements of construction, between equipment and floors, openings leading to voids and hollow spaces in walls, equipment legs and bases, in conduits, motor housings, junction or switch boxes. Prior to application de-energize electrical equipment. After application allow time for oil to evaporate before starting motors or placing switches in "ON" position. Care should be taken to avoid depositing the product onto exposed surfaces or in reaching the material into them. Avoid contamination of food or food processing surfaces.

APPLICATIONS OF THIS PRODUCT IN THE FOOD AREAS OF FOOD HANDLING ESTABLISHMENTS OTHER THAN AS A CRACK AND CREVICE TREATMENT ARE NOT PERMITTED.

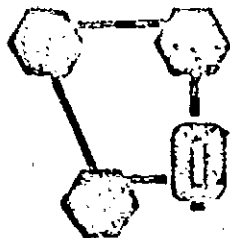
SERVING AREAS: Facilities where foods are served such as dining rooms, but excluding areas where foods may be prepared or held, apply as a spot treatment to selective surfaces, such as baseboards, under elements of construction and into cracks and crevices. Do not treat surfaces likely to be contacted by food. (Do not apply when facility is in operation or foods are exposed.)

NON-FOOD AREAS: Including garbage rooms, lavatories, floor drains (to sewers) entries and vestibules, offices, locker rooms, machine rooms, boiler rooms, garages, mop closets and storage (after canning or bottling). Apply to baseboard areas, around water pipes, surfaces behind and beneath sinks, lockers, tables, pallets and similar areas where insects hide or through which they may enter. Repeat treatment as required.

CARPET BEETLES: Spray edges of carpeting and under carpeting and rugs. Make localized application to the floor and baseboards. Spray directly into cracks, closets and infested areas of shelving. Repeat as necessary.

BROWN DOG TICKS: Thoroughly spray sleeping quarters of animals. Spray infested areas around baseboards, windows and door frames, wall coverings. Applications should be repeated as necessary. Fresh bedding should be placed in animal quarters following treatment. **DO NOT TREAT ANIMALS WITH FORMULATION.**

FLIES, MOSQUITOES, WASPS AND SMALL FLYING MOTHS OUTDOOR USE: For outdoor use only as an aid in reducing annoyance from these insects. Spray outside surfaces of screen doors, window frames or wherever insects may enter the room. Also treat surfaces around light fixtures on porches, in garages, and other places where these insects alight or congregate.

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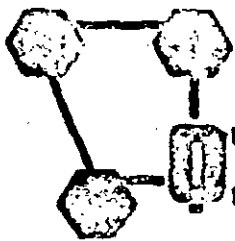
