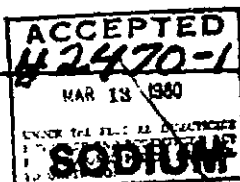

GENERAL CLASSIFICATION**

IT IS A POLYMER OF FORMALDEHYDE. SAME QUALITY AS A BLEACHER INCONSISTENT WITH IT.

DIRECTIONS FOR SWIMMING POOL CHLORINATION:
For a free pool or for filling start up, add 1/2 lb. of sodium hypochlorite solution for each 1000 gallons of water to 1 ppm available chlorine by weight.

DIRECTIONS FOR SANITIZING FOOD PREPARATION:
Use 1/2 lb. of sodium hypochlorite solution for each 1000 gallons of water to 1 ppm available chlorine by weight. Use 1/4 lb. of sodium hypochlorite solution for each 500 gallons of water to 1 ppm available chlorine by weight.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL:
Store in a cool, dry place. Do not store near acids. Do not store in a metal container. Do not store in a plastic container. Do not store in a glass container. Do not store in a wooden container.
