

4. Submit additional information on stability, Guideline Reference Number (GRN) 63-13. This information must include a discussion of the sensitivity of the active ingredient to metal ions and metal, stability at normal and elevated temperatures, and sensitivity to sunlight. Please submit this information by November 30, 1990.
5. Submit five (5) copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment. Refer to the A-79 enclosure for a further description of final printed labeling.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA sec. 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions.
