STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

If Swallowed: Call a physician or Poison Control Center immediately. Immediately give several glasses of water and induce vomiting by placing finger on the back of the victims tongue. Give fluids until vomitus is clear. Do not induce vomiting or give anything by mouth to an unconscious person or convulsing person.

If Inhaled: Remove victim to fresh air. Get medical attention if respiratory irritation occurs. Apply artificial respiration if indicated.

If on Skin: In case of contact, remove contaminated clothing and immediately wash skin with soap and water. Avoid abrading the skin.

If In Eyes: Flush eyes with plenty of water for 15 minutes. Hold eyelids apart to ensure rinsing of the entire surface of the eyes. Call a physician immediately. SEE NOTE TO PHYSICIAN ON SIDE PANEL.

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NOTE TO PHYSICIAN

DORSAN (chlorpyrifos) is a cholinesterase inhibitor. Initial measures include removal of secretions, maintenance of a patent airway and, if necessary, artificial respiration. When cyanosis is relieved, atropine may be administered in large therapeutic doses, repeated as necessary to the point of tolerance. If symptoms warrant further treatment, pralidoxime chloride, 2-PAM chloride) has shown utility as adjunctive therapy. Never use morphine. Continued absorption of the poison may occur, resulting in fatal relapse after initial improvement, very close supervision of the patient is indicated for at least 48 to 72 hours.
