Dear Ms. Thaxton:

The revised labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA) as amended, is acceptable, provided you incorporate the Agency's condition identified below and submit one copy of your final, printed labeling prior to releasing the product for shipment. A stamped copy of the current label is enclosed for your files.

1. In the "Note to Physician" section, in the last sentence, place a period after the word "improvement" and capitalize the word "very" to begin what will become the final sentence.

Your release for shipment of the product bearing the amended labeling constitutes acceptance of this condition. As noted in the June 11, 1997 Federal Register Notice, you may sell or distribute product under the previously approved labeling for a period of 18 months from this date. The Agency understands, however, that in correspondence from you dated May 29, 1997, Luxembourg-Pamol voluntarily agreed that the sale of this chlorpyrifos product within the United States will only occur with this revised labeling.

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

NOTE TO PHYSICIAN

DORSAN (Chlorpyrifos) is a cholinesterase inhibitor. Initial measures include removal of secretions, maintenance of a clear airway and, if necessary, artificial respiration. When cyanosis is relieved, atropine may be administered in large therapeutic doses, repeated as necessary to the point of tolerance. If symptoms warrant further treatment, protopam chloride (2-PAM, pralidoxime chloride) has shown utility as adjunctive therapy. Never use morphine. Continued absorption of the poison may occur, resulting in fatal relapse after initial improvement, very close supervision of the patient is indicated for at least 48 to 72 hours.

Pest Control Indoors: Crack and crevice, spot and bait treatments in and around non-food areas of residential and non-residential buildings and structures.

This product may **NOT** be used for formulation into manufacturing-use or end-use products for the following uses:

Pest Control Indoors: Indoor broadcast use; total release foggers for indoor residential and non-residential (except greenhouses) use; coating products intended for large surface areas such as floors, walls and ceilings inside residential dwellings, offices, schools or health care institutions including but not limited to houses, apartments, nursing homes and patient rooms in hospitals, paint additives, and animal dips, shampoos, sprays or dusts.

All manufacturing-use products produced from this product must bear a statement prohibiting formulation of such products for the uses identified above.
