Aquatic weed control in lakes, ponds, marshes, reservoirs, bayous, drainage ditches, canals, rivers and streams that are quiescent or slow moving.

To be applied by federal, state or local public agency personnel trained in aquatic weed control or by licensed commercial applicators under contract to the above agencies.

Before application under any project program, coordination and approval of local and state authorities may be required, either by letter of agreement or issuance of special permits for such use.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

WATERHYACINTH (Eichornia crassipes) CONTROL:

Apply to actively growing waterhyacinth.

AERIAL APPLICATION - Use 2 to 4 quarts of 2,4-D Amine No. 4 in 5 to 15 gallons of water to cover one surface acre..

BOAT APPLICATION - Use 2 to 4 quarts of 2,4-D Amine No. 4 in 50 to 100 gallons of water per acre. Uniform coverage is essential. Avoid submerging plants after treatment.

Do not make surface applications when the wind speed exceeds 10 mph. Do not make aerial applications when the wind speed exceeds 5 mph.

NOTE: Treatment of aquatic weeds can result in oxygen loss from decomposition of dead weeds. This loss can cause fish suffocation. Therefore, to minimize this hazard, treat 1/3 to 1/2 of the water area in a single operation and wait at least 10 to 14 days between treatments. Begin treatment along the shore and proceed outwards in bands to allow fish to move into untreated areas.

Do not use treated water for irrigation or domestic purposes for 3 weeks after treatment or until such time that the water does not contain greater than 0.1 ppm 2,4-D acid. Treated water should not be used to irrigate susceptible crops such as grapes, tomatoes and cotton.

In order to assure maximum safety and weed control, follow label recommendations on this label and all the cautions and limitations on the package label.
