

- c. The maximum application rate to turf is the lower of (1) existing application rate on currently registered label or (2) 2 pounds 2,4-D acid equivalent per application per site. The maximum number of broadcast applications per treatment site is 2 per year.
- d. The following reentry statement must be included: "Do not allow people (other than applicator) or pets on treatment area during application. Do not enter treatment areas until spray has dried or dust has settled.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Storage: Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal. Open dumping is prohibited. Do not store this product near fertilizers, seeds, insecticides, or fungicides. Reclose all partially used containers by tightening all bungs securely. Contents of damaged containers which cannot be repaired, or which cannot be used immediately, should be transferred to suitable sound containers and properly marked. Absorb any spilled material with a suitable clay absorbent and dispose of as indicated under "Pesticide Disposal."


