DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. Always use freshly mixed solution. Use soft water whenever possible. Do not use on new transplants, newly potted shrubs or when plants are stressed by drought. Do not apply to plants in full sun. For control of ADELGIDS, APHIDS, EARWIGS, MEALYBUGS, PLANT BUGS, PSYLLIDS, ROSE SLUG, SAWFLIES, SCALES, SPIDER MITES, THRIPS and WHITEFLY on flowers, foliage plants, shrubs, trees, fruits and vegetables grown in and around the home MIX 2 TSP. (2.0 TBS. PER GAL. OF WATER). Apply whenever insects appear being sure to thoroughly wet both surfaces of infested leaves. For aphids and mealybugs spray again after 2 or 3 days. For other pests spray weekly for 2 or 3 weeks for best results.

INDOOR PLANTS: Use as directed above. Be sure that spray penetrates dense foliage in well-lit areas. Do not use on Green Sticks, test spray other euphorbias. Do not use on Dracena, Dieffenbarr, ornamental cacti, palm plants, palms or delicate ferns without testing the plant first. For ROOT MEALYBUGS, combine with mild solution of 1 TBS. per gallon of water.

FLOWERS, BEDDING PLANTS, TREES AND SHRUBS: Use as directed above. For rose slug spray directly on feeding larvae. For adelgids, psyllids and scales spray during period of peak egg hatch and crawler activity and repeat as necessary. Do not use on bleeding heart, gardenias, saffron, rose, chestnut, Japanese maple, mountain ash, yucca, Eucalyptus, or Crataegus plus spruce. Do not spray on camellias, larches and impatiens for varietal sensitivity. Do not apply to tender growth. For other pests, spray may result in the temporary removal of glaucous or waxy bloom from spruce. For other pests, spray aggregations spray with 2 TSP. (2.0 TBS. PER GALLON OF WATER) apply directly to the insects.

VEGETABLES: Use as directed above on TOMATOES, PEPPERS and EGGPLANT to control aphids, spider mites and whitefly. Do not use on COLE CROPS to control aphids and leaf miner. Do not use on day of harvest and on CUCUMBERS, SQUASH and MELONS to control aphids, spider mites, squash bug and whitefly. Do not use on day of harvest.

FRUIT TREES: Use as directed above on APPLES and PEARS to control aphids, whitefly, scale, crawler, mealybug, psyllid and pear leaf miner. Do not use on day of harvest. Do not use on day of harvest on citrus trees, lemons and limes. Do not use on day of harvest on APRICOTS, NECTARINES and PEACHES. Do not use on day of harvest on PLUMS, APRICOTS, NECTARINES and PEACHES. Do not use on day of harvest on NECTARINES, APRICOTS and PEACHES.

GREENHOUSES: Use as directed above on all insects and mites. Do not use on day of harvest. Do not use on day of harvest on day of harvest.
