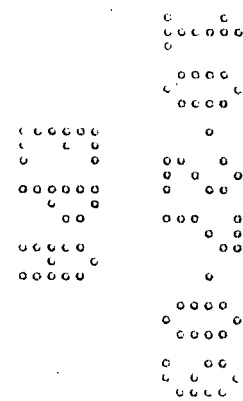

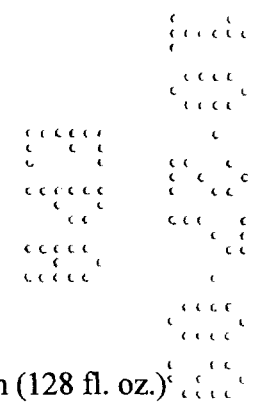

Be sure to spray undersides of leaves where insects feed and rest. For other pests, apply spray directly to the insect. Root mealybug and springtail infestations can be reduced using a soil drench of 6.5 Tablespoons (19.5 teaspoons) of Safer® Brand Insect Killer in a quart of warm water once a month.

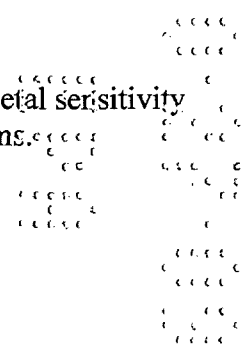
