Spray around baseboards as well as floors, carpets and upholstered furniture wherever pets rest. Be sure that carpets are thoroughly moistened and that spray penetrates carpet pile to the backing. Vacuum treated carpet about 30 minutes after spraying. Repeat application at 2 week intervals during the flea season. Flea Guard can be used to spray or wash pet bedding.

NOTE: Diluted spray will not stain or discolor color-fast fabrics; for noncolor-fast fabrics test before spraying. Do not use on suede, flocked wallpaper or other specialty fabrics.
