#### STORAGE & DISPOSAL

Store at room temperature & protect from  
freezing. Do not reuse empty container. Rinse  
thoroughly before discarding in trash.

#### DIRECTIONS FOR USE

To control **APHIDS, MITES, WHITEFLY** and **THRIPS**  
spray thoroughly to wet all infested surfaces, or dip  
foliage portion of plant in spray solution taking care to  
avoid loss of soil. Repeat treatment at 7 to 10 day  
intervals. Protect blossoms, or rinse with water after  
treatment to avoid spotting. Do not allow excess spray  
solution or water to sit in center of plant. Keep plants  
out of direct sun while foliage is wet.

To control **ROOT MEALYBUGS**, be sure soil is moist,  
then pour solution evenly over the soil surface until  
drainage begins. Leave excess solution in watering  
saucer to be re-absorbed by the soil. Repeat in  
7 to 10 days.
